FAWS Pet Supplies HURRICANE PET SURVIVAL GUIDE

love means being prepared

your pets cannot survive a flood and or storm without your help



A basic list of items you will need

to be well prepared include:

- * Cage or carrier w/picture id
- * food (can & dry) and fresh water
(2 weeks supply minimum)
- * can opener & can lids
- * ID tags/license on pet
- * ID on all belongings
- * proof of vaccination(s)
- * medical records
- * specific care instructions
- * vitamins * medicines
- * dishes * bedding
- * litter & litter pan/scoop

- * first aid items .. e.g. styptic powder, pink stuff, bandages
 - * paper/plastic bags for waste
 - * chew and play toys
 - * dry shampoo
 - * combs & brushes
 - * flea control for pet and home
 - * treats *(most important!)*
 - * muzzle/calms for "just in case.."
- Your pet, though normally very calm, may become very nervous and irritable, and subject

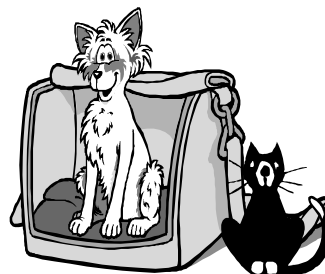
to behavior he/she would not normally exhibit such as biting. This is because he/she is aware that all two legged animals are a little hyper! Your pet will not understand what is going on with out your help and understanding. Start packing now! Don't wait!

Hurricane season is upon us and we have been told to plan for our family but have you planned what you will need to care for your pet(s), should an evacuation be necessary. It is NOT too soon! **PLAN NOW.** Avoid that last minute panic rush at the stores for supplies. Make sure where your pet(s) will be accepted when there is an evacuation. Be it a motel, a friends, a relatives, your vets/ kennels shelter ... make your reservation now! It is not too early. Space is limited!



Pets cannot plan .. only humans can! No pet deserves to be left on their own. Please .. do NOT leave your pet locked in the house .. they could be lost forever!

Remember - Shelters do NOT take animals!
